

Children are expected to display the YMCA Core values while in our Adventure Area. Staff will encourage these values to promote a safe environment for your child as well as a healthy spirit, mind, and body for all. Parents will be notified in the case that their child displays any unacceptable behavior.

Staff reserves the right to call a parent /guardian in the case of excessive crying and or tantrums. Please be advised that staff may request a parent or guardian to release a child from the Adventure Area if the child is causing an excessive disturbance. This is done on a case by case basis and requires Supervisors permission.

Ages: The Adventure Area is designed for children in a mixed age group including those no younger than 6 weeks through no older than 7 years.

Time limitations: We ask that you limit your child's use of the Adventure Area to no longer than 90 minutes. This allows for all members to enjoy this service, this policy will be strictly enforced.

Activities: During your child's stay in the Adventure Area, he/she will enjoy many different activities and crafts. Staff tries to plan activities that all toddlers and young children can participate in. Infants will be included in as many activities as possible, but always in the interaction with other children and staff.

Procedures: Parents are asked to introduce themselves and their children to the staff on duty. There is a sign in/out sheet with staff names, PLEASE COMPLETE ALL INFORMATION and add any comments or special instructions for your child's stay including; naps, demeanor, play activities, and any health issues the staff should be made aware of. A wristband with corresponding numbers will be placed on both you and your child so that only you may pick them up from our care. You are asked to remain in the building at all times while your child is signed in at the Adventure Area.

Health & Safety: All children who are ill are EXCLUDED from this program. This exclusion includes the following symptoms; fever, unexplained rashes, vomiting, and unexplained runny noses.

Due to the adventurous manner of infants and young children we request that NO SHOES be worn by parents and children while in the area. SOCKS ARE REQUIRED in the Adventure Area at all times.

All children are required to wash their hands with warm soapy water before entering the Adventure Area. Please use the restroom in the Lobby Area.

Lost & Found: The YMCA is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items. Toys brought from home or elsewhere are not permitted in the Adventure Area.



Eating: There is absolutely no food or beverage permitted in the Adventure Area. Children must have eaten before being left in our care.

Changing: Staff will not change your child's diaper. In the event of your child needing to be changed you will be paged to do so. If you are in the pool, staff will do this only with prior approval on the sign in sheet. Please make the staff aware if your child is toilet training or will need assistance in using the restroom.
