Coaches who wish to put in a team, please encourage parents to be at sign up because you will not be allowed to sign up any players as a coach other than your own.

Game Sites: All games are scheduled to be played at the Spoon's Courts, located at 19th Street between French and Holland Streets. Additional sites may be added depending upon total number of eligible player.

League Play: is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 18, 2012 for the boys and Tuesday, June 19, 2012 for the girls. Game schedules will be given to players and coaches one once teams have been determined. **There will be no exceptions regarding registration procedures.**

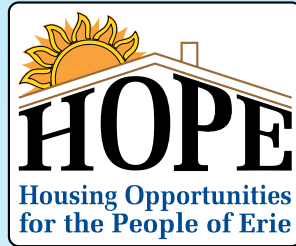
